Dear Parent/Guardian,

As poor weather and road conditions dictate, we will have two options to help keep school buses and our teen drivers safe this year: Snow Routes or 2 Hour Late Start.

When poor road conditions exist, we may call for snow routes at scheduled, safe and centralized locations. School will begin at regular time on Snow Route Days. If we must call for snow routes in the morning then please plan for snow routes and the same stop location in the afternoon. If road conditions improve for the afternoon route, another parent alert notification will be sent (emergency status) to let you know your child will be dropped off at their regular afternoon route stop location. Otherwise, please plan on the exact same snow routes in the afternoon.

For mornings when road conditions could improve quickly, we may call for a 2 Hour Late Start Schedule. For a 2 Hour Late Start, each building will begin school two hours late and end school at regular time as follows:

Primary (PK-1):	10:40 am – 3:40 pm
Elementary (2-3):	10:30 am – 3:30 pm
Upper Elementary (4-6):	10:35 am – 3:35 pm
Middle School (7-8):	9:40 am – 2:35 pm
High School (9-12):	9:30 am – 2:30 pm

**Regardless of whether we have Snow Routes or 2 Hour Late Start, each building will open at its regular time for student drop offs and before school cat care. However, we do ask that parents bringing their children to school come two hours late if at all possible.*

As always, we encourage you to contact your child's school bus driver directly should you have suggestions or concerns associated with bus stops in any weather condition. Thank you again for your patience and cooperation to keep our students safe.
